A Revision Session



Decide on what topic you are going to revise in the session.
Remember - Spend more time on the topics you find hardest.

Complete a **BRAIN DUMP**.

- get a blank piece of paper.
- write as much information down as you can remember about the topic.
- use highlighters or a key to organise or group the information you have remembered into key elements, categories or themes.

Use **FLASH CARDS, REVISION GUIDES, KNOWLEDGE ORGANISER, EXERCISE BOOK**, etc. to add anything you have forgotten or correct anything you got wrong in your brain dump.

Find a **PAST PAPER** question on the topic you are revising and have a go at answering it **TO TIME** in **EXAM CONDITIONS**

Take a 5 minute break.

Compare your answer to the marks scheme or an exemplar marked answer. Add in/change/refine your answer so that it is as perfect as you can make it.

Go back to your **BRAIN DUMP** and add anything you have forgotten or correct anything you got wrong in your brain dump from the model answer or mark scheme.

BLURT your brain dump.
